COST OF THE TOUR

\$4,295 per person, double occupancy

\$8,590 per couple double occupancy

Includes – Round trip airfare & land package

(Add \$150 per person after February 1, 2007)

Registration is based on first come first served. These tours have a tendency to sell out early, so we suggest you book early to reserve your space. After **February 1, 2007**, the price will be based on the going-rate for airfare and hotel rates.

Registration Deposit: To register and reserve your space, send just \$500 per couple, or \$250 per single. (\$50 per person is non-refundable.)

Second Payment due February 1, 2007. Full payment options to lock in tour cost or \$2,000 per person. (50% tour cost is non-refundable.)

Final Payment due June 1, 2007. Total balance due (100% non refundable.)

Tour prices are based on two persons sharing one room. Singles wishing to have a private room, **single room supplements** are available for an additional \$400 per person.

Not included: Entrance fees to attractions not listed as advertised, excess baggage, personal items, telephone calls, trip cancellation & medical insurance, laundry, beverages, lunches, three evening meals and food & drink items not on our scheduled menus.

If you are departing before or returning later than the scheduled tour, or wish to purchase the land package only, please let us know your intentions not later than **February 1, 2007**.

Land Package Only: If you wish to do your own air arrangements, subtract \$750 per person. You will be responsible to meet our bus at the Munich Airport or at the Hotel in Grassau. Meet The Staff

Jerry Haag started calling in Cheyenne, WY in 1955. At the time, he was working full time with the Air National Guard until 1967 when he became a full time caller. His tours took him as a featured caller to all 50 states all Provinces of Canada and several countries throughout the world. Jerry helped establish CALLERLAB and served on the board for a decade. He was later awarded the CALLERLAB milestone award. He is the recipient of three gold records. Jerry & Sherry have been married over 50 years; have two daughters and one grandson. Jerry became semi-retired

in 2001 where he continues to call but not 365 days a year. Time to back off and play a little more golf.

Gary Shoemake started calling in Tulsa, OK in 1964 and went full time in 1968. His travels have taken him to all 50 states, as well as Canada, Mexico, England, Scotland, New Zealand, Japan, Sweden, Germany and Denmark. Gary, Lisa and daughter Katie make their home in the Smoky Mountains of Tennessee. During the winter months, they live in Mesa AZ where Gary calls a full program from beginners through A-2. After many years of being co-owner of Chaparral Records with Ken Bower, Jerry Haag and Marshall Flippo they decided to sell the label to Palomino Records. Although these callers still do several Chaparral Weekends around the nation, Gary now records freelance for several companies including Chaparral, Rhythm, ESP, Blue Star, and Crown.

Marshall Flippo has been a full time national caller for the past 50 years, an inspiration in the square dance industry. Marshall & Sharon now live in Tucson, AZ. Marshall conducts a full square dance program at the Rincon Country West RV Park and still finds time to travel around the country doing festivals and special dances. Flip has recorded countless records, including two gold recordings on Blue Star Records and is the recipient of the prestigious CALLERLAB Milestone Award. Flippo continues to display endless stamina as one of the most popular callers of our time.

Ken Bower was first introduced to square dancing in 1961 and within 1 year starting calling. By 1965 he was traveling full time. He has called in every state in the US along with Australia, China, England, Germany, Japan, New Zealand, Taiwan and Sweden to name a few. He records on several different recording labels. He works at Golden Village Palms Travel Trailer Park in Hemet, CA from Oct-Apr calling dances and teaching classes from beginners to advance. During the summer he travels calling one-night stands and working square dance weekends. Ken and his wife, Dee, come from Iowa and moved to California in 1973. They have three children, six grandchildren and five great grandchildren.

Tom & Gina, your tour hosts, are from Tucson AZ where they operate a self-care horse ranch. Gina has made a career in the restaurant business and knows how to cater to people. Tom & Gina have lead tours to Grassau over the past 12 years. They know the area, speak the language and can show you places of interest that most tourists miss. Gina comes from a small Bavarian village just south of Munich. Tom started calling while stationed with the Canadians in Germany in 1968. Now retired from the Air Force after 26 years, half his military career was spent in Germany. Tom especially enjoys contras and traditional squares.
